Power wheels will be dropped off at the pit entrance by 3:45 p.m.

1. Open to ages 3-10 years old. (Age groups 3-6 and 7-10) Use good judgment for younger kids. If you think they can handle it, that's great, but don't force them to do it. It's for FUN!!!
2. Helmets must be worn at all times. Bicycle helmets are OK.
3. Power wheels can be converted to 12 12-volt lawn mower battery or equivalent, but must be secure and covered away from the child.
4. All doors and tailgates must be strapped shut using only duct tape or zip ties. Must have no sharp edges.
5. Factory plastic bumpers must remain in place. No reinforcing and no tilting of the body.
6. The motor must remain factory with NO modifications besides battery conversion.
7. You may use 1-6" wide strips of rubber on each tire for traction. No snowmobile tracks or off-road vehicle rubber allowed. The rubber may be installed by glue or screws inward. Screws, nails, and studs are not allowed outward.
8. Absolutely NO other modifications or aftermarket accessories may be used unless mentioned above. NO shifters, NO bigger motors/tires, etc.)
9. Decorative changes can be made to the power wheels to make it look like a derby car, but it cannot reinforce the power wheel. Only add decoration.
10. If you have modifications you shouldn't have done, your child will not be able to run, plain and simple. NO EXCEPTIONS!!!
11. When the power wheels are over, all children must leave the pit area immediately.
